TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

Hibiscus Contractors Limited were the main contractor developing the Gulf Harbour golf course in conjunction with the excavation of the Waterways Canals in the mid 1990's.

We confirm the golf course was only constructed to standards applicable at the time for recreation reserves, a standard which is different and not suitable for housing.

Of particular note are the areas around the lake which was an 18m deep gully behind Wentworth Primary School. This is where a compacted earth clay dam face was constructed to accommodate approximately 1 million meters of marine mud. This was finished with 2 meters of clay placed over the mud with minimal compaction to form holes 7 and 9.

Another area of note is the driving range at the left-hand side of Pinecrest Drive where marine mud from the eastern arm of the marina was placed. This also had a minimal amount of compaction and clay overlay.

All surrounding areas we were involved with, in conjunction with the golf course, has sewer and stormwater drainage crossing parts of the golf course.

It was a privilege to work for Singaporean developers and top U.S.A golf course designers who had a vision of building a golf course to be proud of. The course was far ahead of its years and now we have someone wanting to destroy all the hard work and open space.
