Keep Whangaparāoa's Green Spaces (KWGS) is appalled and saddened at the overnight fire which occurred at the Gulf Harbour Country Club. We believe the fire was confined the clubhouse Golf Pro Shop and is now out. As at 0700 Saturday 18 May 2024 fire appliances are still on site.

The community has been calling on authorities and the owner to secure the clubhouse buildings since the golf club abruptly closed in July 2023. Since then the clubhouse has been subject to extensive graffiti and vandalism. KWGS supporters have been disappointed that no attempt has been made to fence the clubhouse site off and make it secure.

Yesterday, Friday 17 May, High Court action by Inovagen Ltd seeking to put the GHCC owners, Long River Investments into liquidation over unpaid debt did not proceed. KWGS understand that a last minute settlement was made.
